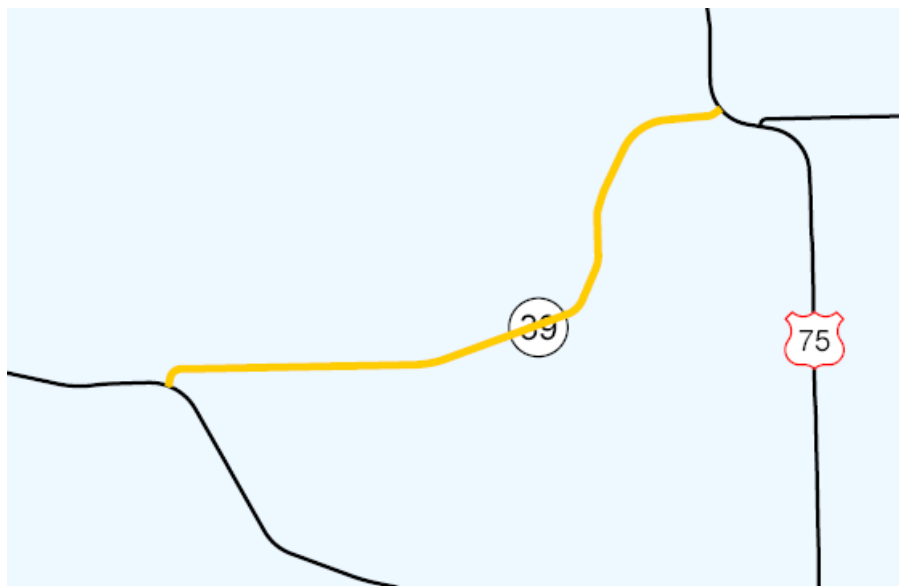

Asphalt patching on K-39 next week

The week of July 23-27 maintenance crews with the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will place asphalt patches on K-39 between the west U.S. 75/K-39 junction and the U.S. 400/K-39 junction in Wilson County.

A pilot car operation will guide one-lane traffic through the work zone during daylight hours. Travelers can expect delays of 15 minutes or less. KDOT reminds drivers to watch for the signs, slow down and "Give 'Em a Brake!" in the work zone.
