KDOT to begin survey on K-68 west of Ottawa

Starting Monday, May 13, and continuing for two weeks, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will conduct a survey along K-68 in Franklin County. The survey begins near the east city limits of Pomona and continues east for 8½ miles, ending at Eisenhower Road at Ottawa.

The survey team will obtain information to support a study for possible improvements to the K-68 corridor. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. The survey is based on the existing highway alignment. Elevations will be obtained on the BNSF Railroad crossing east of Pomona.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Rob Selley, L.S., Party Chief, will be in charge of this survey for KDOT.
