## **Secretary of Transportation to announce Geometric Improvement projects at Girard on Friday**

This Friday Kansas Secretary of Transportation Mike King will announce the cities that have been selected to receive funding under Kansas Department of Transportation's Geometric Improvement Program for fiscal year 2016.

Secretary King will make the announcement during a ceremony starting at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Sept. 27, in front of Girard High School, 415 N. Summit, Girard, Kan. Girard City Administrator Gary Emry will serve as master of ceremonies for the event, which is open to the public. In case of inclement weather the event will be moved into the Girard High School auditorium.

Geometric improvement projects improve intersections and address road deficiencies. Roads selected for Geometric Improvement funding are part of the state highway system but located within city limits.
