UP crossing repairs at Neodesha next week

The Union Pacific (UP) Railroad plans to close its crossing on U.S.75 (Main Street) at Neodesha to all traffic for repairs one day next week. According to UP officials, the crossing will be closed from approximately 3:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Monday, Aug. 19, or during the same time period on Tuesday, Aug. 20.

The detour for southbound U.S.75 traffic: from U.S.75 turn onto 4th Street; continue north on 4th to Granby Avenue; travel west on Granby to U.S.400; continue southeast on U.S.400 to U.S.75.

The detour for northbound U.S.75 traffic: from U.S.75 turn onto Water Plant Road; continue north on Water Plant to Granby Ave.; travel east on Granby to 4th Street; continue south on 4th to U.S.75.
