K-31 to close for crossroad pipe replacement

Tuesday, Aug. 7, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will close a section of K-31 in Anderson County in order to replace a crossroad pipe. The highway will be closed between Georgia and Harper roads.

Maintenance crews from the Garnett KDOT Area Office will complete the pipe replacement in one day, beginning work at 6:00 a.m. and finishing around 8:00 p.m. Since the roadway will be closed to all through traffic at the work zone, on August 7 motorists should seek alternate routes.
