U.S. 166 bridge resurfacing project to start next Monday

On Monday, July 1, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin a resurfacing project on the U.S. 166 bridge over Onion Creek. The bridge is located on the westbound lanes of the four-lane highway section west of Coffeyville.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane at the bridge and the speed limit will decrease to 55 miles per hour. No delays are expected.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$206,111 to B&B Bridge Company, LLC, of St. Paul, Kan. According to Luke Middleton, construction engineer at the Independence KDOT office, this T-WORKS preservation project should be completed by Labor Day. Middleton reminds motorists to slow down at the work zone, obey the signs and directional arrow board, and "Give 'Em a Brake!"
