KDOT testing highway pavement strength

Thursday and Friday, July 5-6, the Kansas Department of Transportation will run tests of pavement strength on U.S. 75 from Neodesha north to the Wilson- Woodson county line.

The testing crew uses a falling weight deflectometer (FWD), a device equipped with a series of weights that checks the strength of asphalt pavement. Each year KDOT conducts FWD tests on different sections of the state highway system.

A pilot car operation will be used for traffic control at each testing site. Motorists will experience delays of 15 minutes or less. KDOT reminds all drivers to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through the testing zones.
